BACKGROUND:

Under the current contract with the Washington Center, the City of Lacey is entitled to use the facility two days per year at no additional cost. In 1992, the Lacey City Council created the Washington Center Policy to provide guidelines to respond to requests from outside organizations for use of the City's free days at the Washington Center (Attachment 1).

Currently, the policy allocates one free day per year to non-profit organizations, and one for City-sponsored events. The City will not be using their free day in 2017. Therefore, both free days are available for non-profit agencies in 2017 (Attachment 2).

The deadline to submit an application request for a free day in 2017 expired on July 31 of this year. We received the following three applications:

1. Entertainment Explosion – *“The Really Big Shoe (11) Stops Here”* (Attachment 3)
 2. Pizza Klatch – *“Pizza Klatch Gayla”* (Attachment 4)
 3. Rotary Club of Lacey – *“Cool Jazz Clean Water”* (Attachment 5)

ADVANTAGES:

1. Granting the City’s free days provides an opportunity for non-profit organizations to raise funds for its services.

DISADVANTAGES:

1. None.

10.07 Guidelines for Use of Washington Center

The City of Lacey periodically makes the Washington Center available free of charge for events in which the City has a major interest, with the following conditions:

The City of Lacey has two free days available each year at the Washington Center. One *free-day* is designated for City use, and one *free-day* is designated for non-profit use. If the City decides not to sponsor an event, the second *free-day* could be offered to a non-profit agency/organization.

1. Applications will only be accepted from January through July to request a *free-day* in a subsequent year, i.e. to reserve a date in 2004, an application should be submitted between Jan-July of 2003.
2. The requesting group must be non-profit in nature.
3. Use of the Center for the event does not occur more frequently than once each year.
4. No group will receive the use of the City's free day on an annual basis, unless no other eligible applications have been received by the deadline.
5. The event may be used for fund-raising purposes if approved by the Lacey City Council (funds raised in this way would be through admission charges, donation solicitation, or fee assessment).
6. The City determines there is general community interest in the proposed event.
7. The City determines that the activity constitutes a public use that the City is authorized to sponsor.
8. The City will receive formal recognition for its sponsorship, i.e. an announcement during the event, or recognition on a program or flier.
9. The group or individual, using the Center, agrees to hold the City harmless for any claims resulting from use of the Center.
10. Applicant must be willing to meet or comply with all Washington Center rules, regulations, and policies.
11. Applicant agrees to report attendance, participation rate, and other appropriate details in writing.

Procedure:

1. Applicant must complete an *Application for Use of the Washington Center* form and return it to the City Manager's office for processing.
2. City Manager's staff will contact the Washington Center to confirm availability of the date requested.

3. The request will be forwarded to the Community Relations and Public Affairs Committee for consideration. Their recommendation will be presented to the full Council for approval.
4. City Manager's staff will notify the Washington Center and applicant of the Council's decision.

Request: Entertainment Explosion (EE), a 501c3 non-profit organization based in Thurston County, is asking the city to award us one of their 2017 free nights at the Washington Center. *This will be our final request.*

Event: In 2016, EE hosted its tenth annual benefit concert for homeless and needy students, entitled: *A Really Big Shoe 10 Folk Fest*. A record \$34,000 was raised, bringing the 10-year total to a quarter of a million dollars. The EE Board has decided that 2017 will be our final **Big Shoe**. We are an aging organization, lacking younger members willing to take on the myriad of details and responsibilities for such a major undertaking.

So, we're going to pull ourselves up by our proverbial suspenders and do it *one more time*, and we are asking the Lacey City Council to once again back us in this effort. You are one of the key supporters who have stood by us over the years, awarding us free nights six times in ten years in Big Shoes 1, 3, 5, 6, 9, and 10 - in 2007, 2009, 2011, 2012, 2015, and 2016. **This will be our last request.**

Dates: Tech/dress rehearsal is Saturday, March 11, 2017. The Big Shoe is Sunday, March 12, 2017 from 2:00 – 5:00 p.m. We must rent the WA Center for both days, so the Lacey free night could be for either day. Otherwise, the cost to EE per day is over a thousand dollars – which means we'll have a thousand dollars less for the kids.

Proceeds: All proceeds from the Big Shoe – ticket sales, sponsors, donations, and money collected during intermission – are distributed to the homeless and needy student funds

in eight school districts – North Thurston, Tumwater, Rainier, Tenino, Rochester, Yelm, Shelton, and Olympia - and also to Community Youth Services (CYS).

District and CYS fund coordinators use the money *one child at a time* for items they determine as necessary for the homeless and needy students, including food, clothing, housing, transportation, campground/restroom/shower fees, and a wide variety of school-related fees like band and sports and class trips.

Latest numbers from the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction show:


- Over 2,155 homeless students in these districts (up 101 from previous year)
- Thousands more who have dropped out of school or aged out of foster care and are helped by CYS
- 754 homeless kids attending schools in the North Thurston district, up 130 from 624 the previous school year
- 35,511 homeless kids statewide, a 9.1 percent increase over the previous year, and a 62.7 percent increase over 2009-10
- Statewide, 3.3 percent of the kids are homeless

History: You have award EE one of your free nights at the WA Center six different times since the Big Shoe debuted in 2007. This has given EE an extra \$6,000-plus to give to the kids – a great ROI (return on investment) for the city. To date, the Big Shoe has raised just over \$250,000 for the kids; 2.5 percent of that has been available because of the free night awarded to EE six times by our partners in Lacey.

Why the Big Shoe:

- One hundred percent of the money goes to the kids – EE keeps nothing
- EE covers its costs by hosting additional shows throughout the year at locations like Lakefair, Olympia Farmers Market, Panorama, Olympics West, Mother Joe's, Colonial Inn, Garden Courte, and others
- Everyone in EE is 52-88 years old - *seniors helping kids*
- There are no strings attached to the funds – the homeless coordinators put the money where it can do the most good, *helping one child at a time*
- No other organization puts "the money saved" towards a better cause
- We provide funds to the school districts that no other organization does

We hope you will waive your guidelines (one more time) and award a free night two years in a row to EE. This will be our final request, and remember, the money is put to such good use for your kids. Thank you for your past support. Remember, the ***Big Shoe Stops Here.***


