

ORDINANCE NO. 1578

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LACEY RELATED TO THE INTERLOCAL DRUG ENFORCEMENT FUND, REPEALING CHAPTER 3.32 OF THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE, AND APPROVING A SUMMARY FOR PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, as of January 1, 2019, all Thurston County Joint Drug Task Force administrative duties were transferred to Thurston County Sheriff's Department, and

WHEREAS, there is no longer a need for a special fund within the funds and budget of the City of Lacey designated as the interlocal drug enforcement fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 3.32 of the Lacey Municipal Code is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Corrections. The City Clerk and the codifiers of this ordinance are authorized to make necessary corrections to this ordinance including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener's/clerkal errors, references, ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers and any references thereto.

Section 3. The summary attached hereto is hereby approved for publication.
