

RESOLUTION NO. 1091

CITY OF LACEY

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING ENFORCEMENT ACTION AGAINST DELINQUENT LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ASSESSMENTS IN RESPONSE TO THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19).

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, the United States Department of Public Health and Human Services Secretary Alex Azar declared a public emergency for the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) beginning on January 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on February 29, 2020, Governor Jay Inslee signed a Proclamation declaring a State of Emergency exists in all counties in the State of Washington due to the number of confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the state; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020 the Lacey City Council passed Resolution No. 1085 finding the COVID-19 outbreak to constitute an emergency; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, Governor Jay Inslee imposed a "Stay Home, Stay Healthy" order requiring every Washingtonian to stay home unless they are engaged in an essential activity and banning all gatherings for social, spiritual and recreational purposes and ordering all businesses to close unless they are designated as an essential business; and

WHEREAS, while these restrictions are critical in mitigating the rate of spread of the COVID-19 virus, they are having significant negative economic effects on the citizens of Lacey; and

WHEREAS, the Lacey City Council recognizes the health, safety and welfare of City residents is of utmost importance to the City and additional measures are needed to protect and assist the community.

NOW THEREFORE, the Lacey City Council resolves as follows:


Section 1. To assist distressed citizens during this emergency, any section of Title 13 of the Lacey Municipal Code which requires or allows enforcement or penalty action to be taken against delinquent local improvement district assessments or utility local improvement district assessments or delinquent installments thereof is hereby suspended during the effective date of this Resolution.

Section 2. Any Council rules or provisions of the Lacey Municipal Code that are inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby waived and suspended during the term of this Resolution.

Section 3. The provisions of this Resolution shall become effective upon adoption and shall continue until termination of the emergency declared by the City Council on March 19, 2020.
